

Bundaberg Regional Airport provides both short and long stay car parking facilities for guests with all car parks conveniently located adjacent to the airport terminal building for easy access. Bookings are not required for airport parking.

# The parking policy provides FREE parking for the first 30 minutes.

Visitors dropping off or picking up passengers within 30 minutes will not pay for parking. After this period the fee is in accordance with the fee schedule.

# Did you know?

You can use your MasterCard or Visa as an alternative to a paper ticket to enter our car parks. Simply insert or tap your credit card upon entry and do the same when exiting (using the same credit card). Your card will be charged on exit. Using your credit card saves time, reduces paper ticket consumption and the chance of a lost ticket.

## **Parking fees**

Parking Fees - are calculated on a 24 hour basis, for example, if you enter the car park at 6am you will not incur an additional daily fee until after 6am the following day. The parking fees are shown below. Details on how to use the parking system are provided in this brochure.

4-5 hours	\$8.00
5-6 hours	\$10.00
6-12 hours	\$12.00
12-24 hours	\$15.00
2 days	\$28.00
3 days	\$41.00
4 days	\$54.00
5 days	\$67.00
6 days	\$80.00
7 days	\$93.00

Parking is capped at \$13.00 per 24 hour period, or part thereof, thereafter. Lost ticket fee is \$140.00.










## Using the airport parking system



HELP LINE

If you have any questions at the automatic payment machine or exit column simply press the intercom button to speak to one of our airport staff.



#### Step 1

ENTRY – press the flashing button on the ticket dispenser if you want to use a paper ticket, then take the ticket. Taking your ticket activates the entry barrier, which will stay open until you have driven in. The barrier only allows one vehicle to enter the car park at a time. Please don't leave your ticket in your vehicle – they often don't work after being left in the

If you don't want to use a paper ticket, you can tap or insert your credit card as indicated and your time of entry is recorded. Once the entry time is recorded, the entry barrier opens to allow you to drive in.

### Step 2

**LEAVING** - you can pay for your parking using cash or card at the automatic payment machine (APM) located in the terminal by following the instructions on the APM screen. A receipt will be printed for you if you press the receipt button on the APM.

After payment has been made, take your ticket and drive to the exit boom gate. Insert your ticket into the ticket slot of the exit column and the gate will open. If you prefer to pay by credit card, or entered using the card, you can drive to the exit gate where you can tap, or insert your credit card in the credit card slot.

#### Step 2A

If you leave the car park within the 30 minute FREE period, you can go directly to the exit in your vehicle. Insert your ticket (or tap/insert your credit card) at the exit column and the gate will open for you.

#### Step 2B

If you go to the exit column after the 30 minute FREE period and have not already paid at an APM, you can pay for your parking at the exit column. Once your ticket has been inserted into the ticket slot at the exit column, the screen will display the parking fee applicable to your ticket. To pay the displayed parking fee, insert your credit card into the credit card slot or and the transaction will be processed. You can also use the tap and go facility. Following credit transaction approval, the barrier will open for you. A receipt may be obtained at the exit column by pressing the receipt button near the LCD screen.
